How we communicate:

Newsletters

Most of the communication from the schools and district comes in the form of newsletters. Parents do not need to sign up to receive newsletters from the district of the school their child attends. Parents are automatically enrolled through the parent portal but need to make sure that all contact information, including email, is up to date in the portal. Go to <u>www.csdecatur.net/parentportal</u> update information. If parents wish to receive email communication from a school that their child does not attend or community members wish to receive school or district communication, go to <u>www.csdecatur.net/enews</u> to sign up.

Texts and Phone Calls

Schools and the district may use text and phone calls to communicate important information. Phone calls are often reserved for emergencies and attendance notifications. Go to <u>www.csdecatur.net/parentportal</u> to ensure your contact information is up to date.

Websites and Calendars

Websites and calendars are used to communicate important information, dates, and events. If information is incorrect or missing from a website or calendar, please contact the school AA or Wilson Center receptionist.
